# Laminated 8213 Restrictor Fitting Instructions



The Maco Laminated 8213 Restrictor has been designed to comply with the planned alterations to BS8213, the requirements are that where deemed necessary (i.e., bedrooms with small children/babies) a restrictor must be fitted that is released by a coordinated two handed operation. No keys or tools should be required to release the restrictor.

Please follow these guidelines for the correct installation of the Maco laminated 8213 restrictor.

It is important that in order for the 8213 restrictor to function correctly that it is fitted onto the sash.

- Locate and fix the restrictor onto the sash.
  It is normal to fit the restrictor in the same position as the friction stay hinges.
- Position and fix the frame stud onto the outer frame, so that when the window is closed the centre of the release mechanism on the restrictor arm is central with the stud.
- Please note that all screw fixings must be stainless steel.





### **Laminated 8213 Restrictor Operating Instructions**



Your windows have been fitted with a Maco Laminated 8213 restricting device.

It is important that you read these instructions and familiarize yourself with the operation of the restrictor

When you open your window the laminated 8213 restrictor is automatically engaged and restricts how far the window will open. To releases the restrictor please follow the procedure listed bellow.

- Pull the window part way towards the closed position about 20 mm movement of the sash.
- Release and hold open the end piece on the restrictor arm.
- Push the window fully open whilst holding the end piece open until the arm clears the frame stud.
- When you close your window the restrictor automatically reengages onto the frame stud ready for the next time the window is opened.
